

PDL Electronics Environmental Policy

Reason:

- This policy ensures that 'Waste Minimisation' and 'Energy Management' systems are implemented in order to cost effectively manage our process inputs and outputs. It ensures that PDL's positive impact on the environment is enhanced, and it's negative impact reduced.

Policy:

An environmental management system shall be implemented ensuring that

- Environmental improvement objectives and targets are set annually and reviewed quarterly.
- Schneider Electric Environmental Indicators will be compiled annually in accordance with Environmental Directive EN2, "Annual Report: Sustainable Development".
- As far as practicable, waste is recycled, energy use is optimised and pollution minimised.
- Manufacturing processes are developed and reviewed so as to minimise the negative impact on the environment.
- Component selection takes into consideration environmental factors.
- The management system operates in accordance with Schneider Electric Corporate strategy, ISO 14001, and legal and other requirements.
- End of Product Life recycling will take place for all drives returned to PDL Electronics.
- An Environmental Co-ordinator will be nominated to oversee, and ensure compliance to the ISO14001 system.
- Environmental Results will be communicated.
